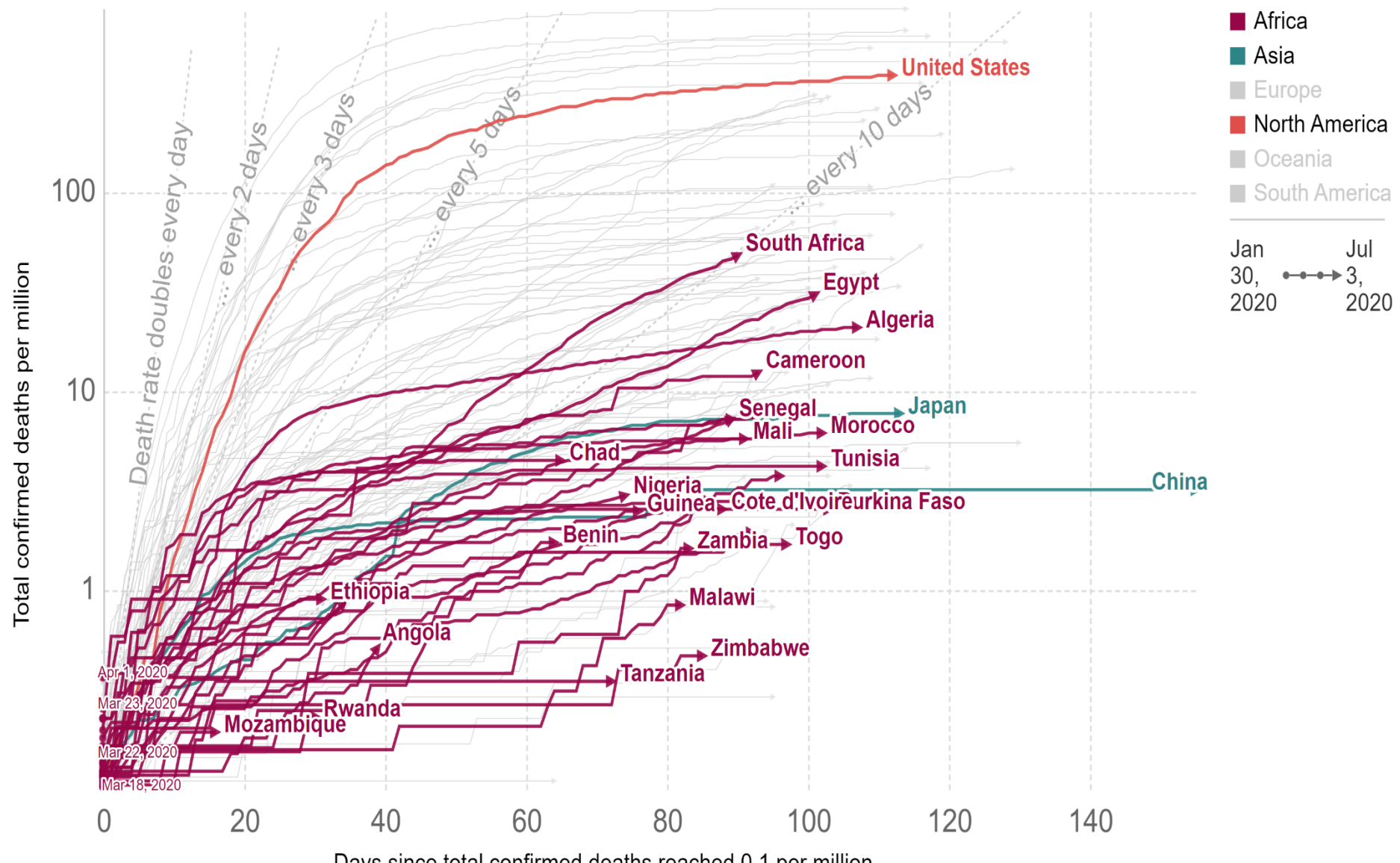

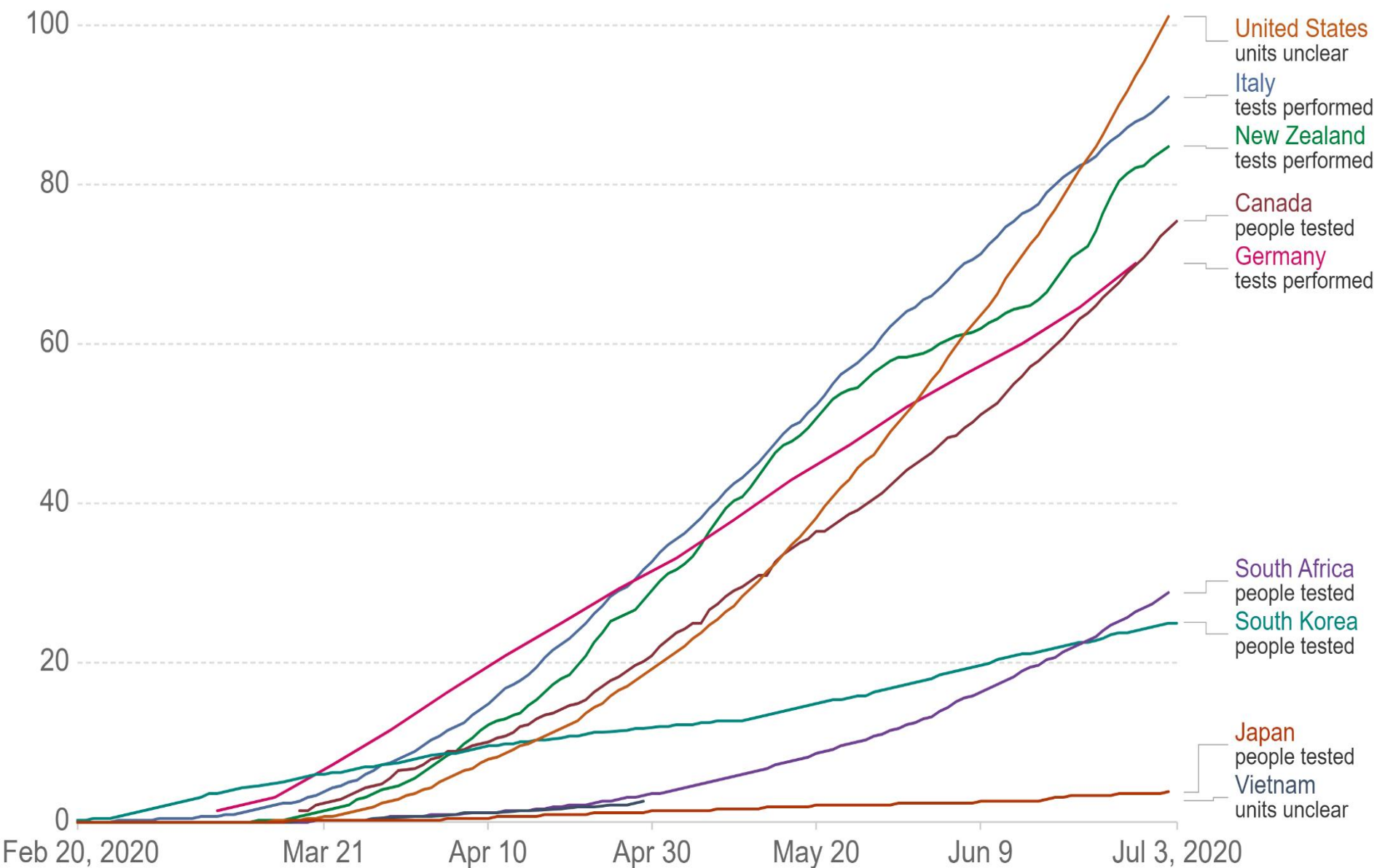

Total confirmed COVID-19 deaths per million: how rapidly are they increasing?

Limited testing and challenges in the attribution of the cause of death means that the number of confirmed deaths may not be an accurate count of the true number of deaths from COVID-19.

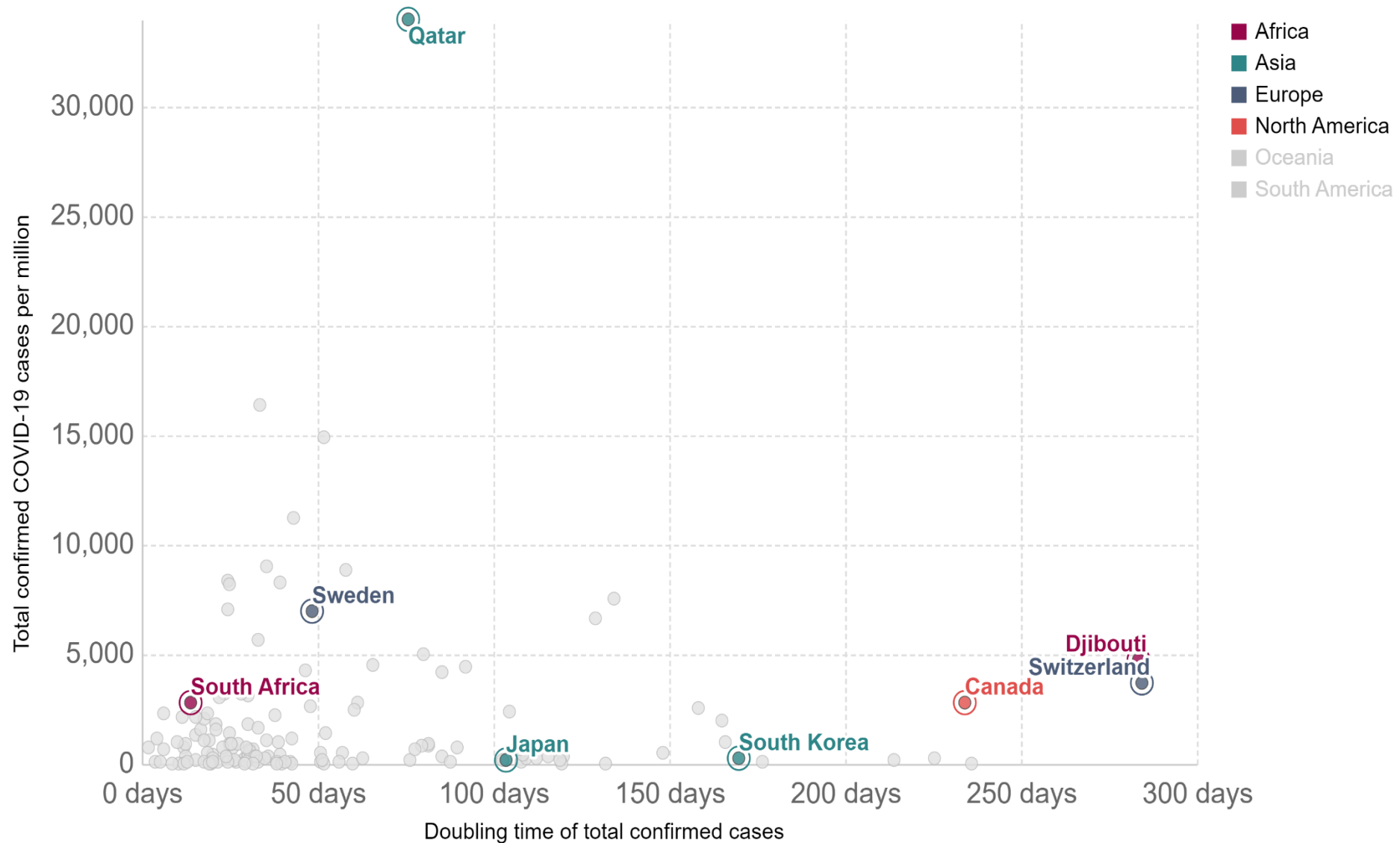


Total COVID-19 tests per 1,000 people



Total confirmed COVID-19 cases per million vs. Doubling time of total confirmed cases, Jul 3, 2020

The number of confirmed cases is lower than the number of total cases. The main reason for this is limited testing.

South Korea learned the lessons of MERS

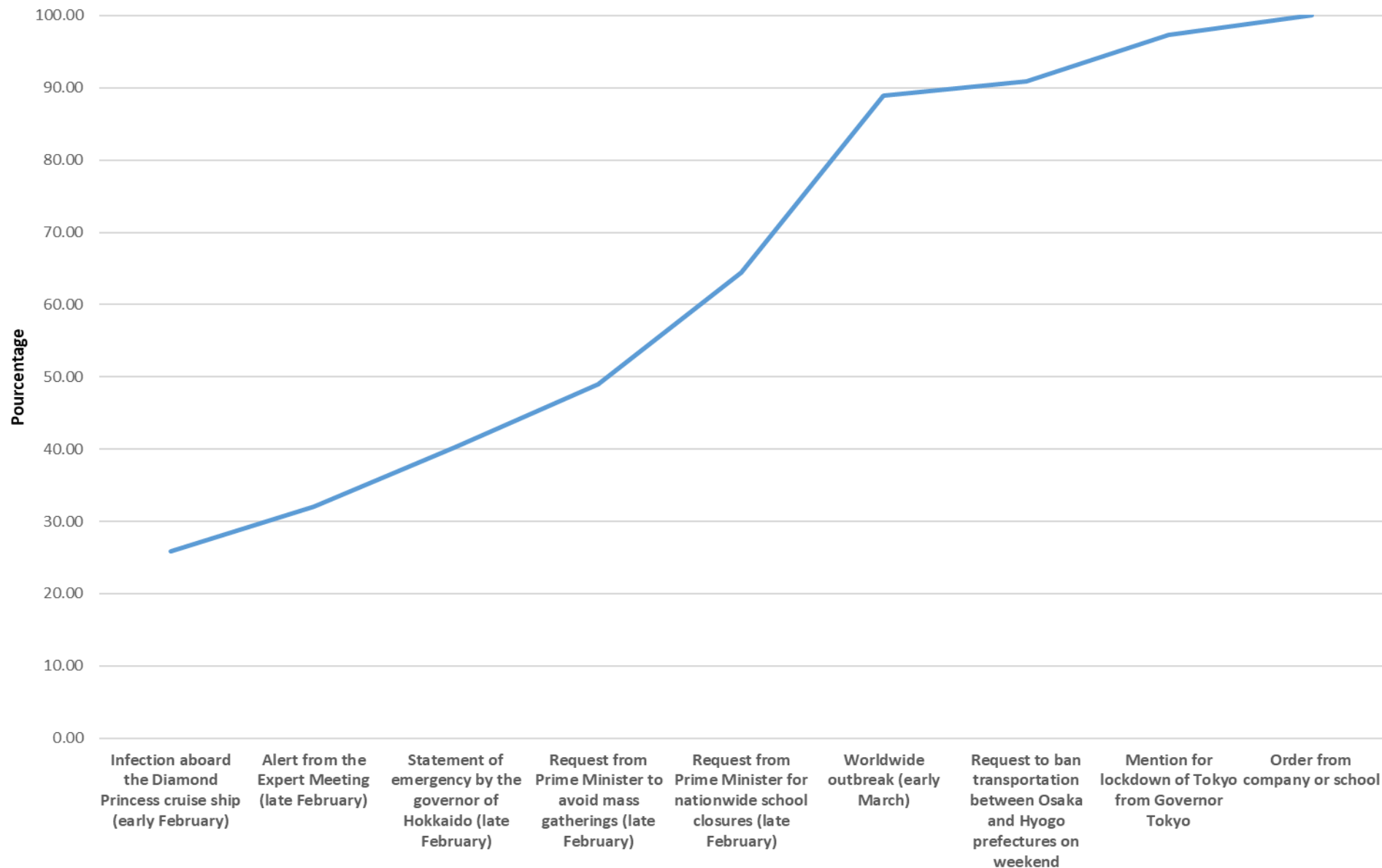
